

Does your child get Medicaid?

Act now or your child may not be covered.

More than 90,000 children in Missouri have lost Medicaid (also called MO HealthNet for Kids) since January 2018. **Your child may be one of them.**

- Did you get a yellow **Annual Renewal form** in an envelope marked “time-sensitive”? The form looks like this image on the right. →
- Did you complete, sign, and return this form by the due date?

Because of mail delays or other problems, it is possible that your child is no longer covered for medical care.

Check to see if your child is still covered by MO HealthNet — even if you sent in a completed form!

MO HealthNet Review Form

Family Support Division needs review information for everyone who has MO HealthNet, at least once a year. We need to complete the review to determine if you or your family members still qualify for MO HealthNet. Please help us by filling out this form. When answering the questions, please answer for every member of your household. If you don't have enough room to answer all of the questions, complete section E or attach additional pages.

The Social Security Number is needed only for those who have MO HealthNet or are applying for MO HealthNet. Race and ethnicity information is used in our reports. You do not have to give us that information.

After you fill out the form, please sign on the last page where it says "Signature/Affirmation." For MO HealthNet for Families, if both parents are in the home, both parents should sign this form.

Please send written proof of your household income when you return this form. Proof could include paycheck stubs for the last month or a letter from your employer. If you are self-employed, send a copy of your latest tax return or self-employment records for the past year.

IMPORTANT! Return this form by _____ to the address listed below. FSD will review it and call or send you a letter if more information is needed. Failure to return this form may result in your MO HealthNet coverage being closed.

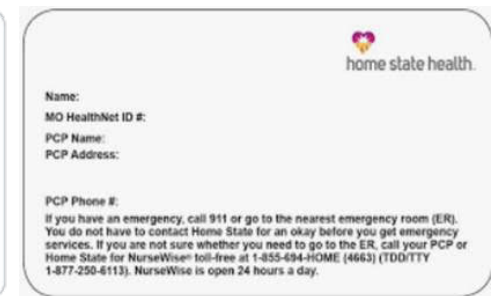

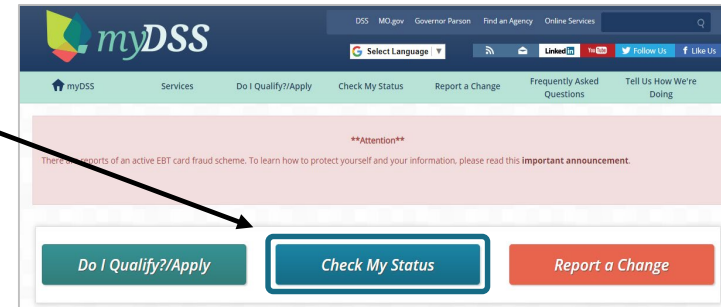

How to check your child's Medicaid coverage:

1. Go to <https://mydss.mo.gov/> and click on the blue "Check My Status" button.
2. If your child has lost coverage, call **855-373-9994** right away to ask the Family Support Division (FSD) "Am I still within 90 days of my child's Annual Review due date?"



Yes

If the FSD says "Yes," you are in a 90-day grace period. **Do this:**

1. Ask them to send an Annual Renewal form.
2. Complete and sign the form and mail it right away to the address on the form. If the FSD receives it within 30 days, they will re-open your case to see if your child is still eligible for coverage. (You do not need to file a new application during a 90-day grace period.)
3. If the FSD finds that your child is still eligible, coverage will continue with no lapse.

If the FSD says "No," you will need to complete a new MO HealthNet application. **Do either of these:**

- Call 855-373-9994 for a paper application
