



The Show-Me School-Based Health Alliance of MO defines school-based health care as the provision of primary, behavioral, oral, or vision health services through a partnership between a school district and health care provider.

Comprehensive school-based health centers are located at a fixed site on a school campus where patients access care. Providers deliver care onsite but may also include some telehealth providers. Provided services **must** include primary health care (prevention, acute/chronic care, and immunizations), behavioral/mental health care (screening, assessment, early intervention, and group and individual counseling), oral care, and vision care. Services are coordinated even if they are delivered by different providers.

School-based health centers are located at a fixed site on a school campus where patients access care. Providers deliver care onsite but may also include some telehealth providers. Provided services **must** include primary health care with care for acute illness and chronic conditions at a minimum. Services may also include oral, vision, or behavioral/mental health care, immunizations, or primary care prevention.

School-based mental health programs are located at a fixed site on a school campus where patients access care. Providers deliver care onsite but may also include some telehealth providers. Provided services only include behavioral/mental health.

School-linked health centers are located off campus at a fixed site near the school campus where patients access care. Providers deliver care at the off school campus site but may also include some telehealth providers. Provided services can include primary, behavioral, oral, or vision health. SLHC programs can include transportation for students from school to the health center or priority appointments for students.

In **Telehealth** exclusive programs, patients access care from a fixed site on the school campus and providers deliver care from a remote location. Provided services can include primary, behavioral, oral, or vision health.

Mobile programs have a mobile van parked on or near school campus where patients access care or a provider that travels to the site but does not offer all services required to be a school-based health center. Providers deliver care onsite but may also include some telehealth providers. Provided services can include primary, oral, or vision health.
