

- Schools MUST provide medical and mental health services if they are necessary for a student to access education.
- Schools CAN NOT bill insurance or guardians when these services are provided.
- The only opportunity for schools to seek reimbursement is when a student is enrolled in Medicaid.
- IDEA has only funded special education services at 15-20%.
- The money from Medicaid reimbursement are unrestricted funds!
- Ultimately, Missouri students benefit when schools participate. For our most vulnerable, medical and mental health services wouldn't be received unless provided by the school.
